NOTICE TO THE MARKET

Transmissora Aliança de Energia Elétrica S.A. (B3: TAEE3, TAEE4 and TAEE11) ("Taesa" or "Company") informs its shareholders, the market in general and other interested parties that the State Secretariat for the Environment and Infrastructure ("SEMA") granted the Preliminary License ("LP") for the sectioning of LT Açailândia – Miranda II, in reference to the facilities for Tangará Transmissora de Energia Elétrica S.A. ("Tangará"). Obtaining this last LP is an important milestone for the project as it attests the social and environmental viability of the entire project.

SEMA also granted the Installation License ("LI") for the substation SE Santa Luzia III of the same concession, which allows works to begin on this substation.

Tangará is a project referring to lot 3 of transmission auction nº 02/2022, held in December 2022, 100% controlled by Taesa. Tangará has a total RAP of R\$ 104.7 million for the 2023-2024 cycle and an ANEEL Capex of R\$ 1,117 million. The project is located in the states of Maranhão and Pará, with approximately 279 km of transmission lines, 72 km of which are double circuit. The deadline stipulated by ANEEL for energizing Tangará is March 2028.
