
Notice to the Market

Transmissora Aliança de Energia Elétrica S.A. (B3: TAE3, TAE4 and TAE11) ("**TAESA**" or "**Company**") hereby informs its shareholders, the market in general, and other interested parties that the National System Operator ("**ONS**") has issued the Release Terms regarding of the Santa Luzia III Substation (500 kV, 230 kV and 138 kV yards) and the sectioning of the 500 kV Açailândia – Miranda II C1 transmission line, under the concession of Tangará Transmissora de Energia Elétrica S.A. ("**Tangará**").

With this energization, Tangará will begin receiving Annual Permitted Revenues ("**RAP**") of approximately R\$ 35.1 million (related to the 2025-2026 cycle), grossed up by PIS/COFINS, corresponding to 32.5% of the project's total RAP, with retroactive effects between February 25th and March 6th, 2026.

The project was partially completed with approximately 24 months ahead of the deadline required by ANEEL of March 2028. This delivery demonstrates TAESA's execution capability and its commitment to its strategic pillars of sustainable growth, financial discipline, operational efficiency, and value creation.

Tangará is a project related to lot 3 of transmission auction 02/2022, held in December 2022, and is 100% controlled by TAESA. Tangará has a total RAP of R\$ 108.3 million for the 2025-2026 cycle and an ANEEL-approved Capex of R\$ 1,117 million. The project is located in the states of Maranhão and Pará, with approximately 279 km of transmission lines, including 72 km of double-circuit lines. ANEEL has set March 2028 as the deadline for Tangará's energization.
