Notice to the Market

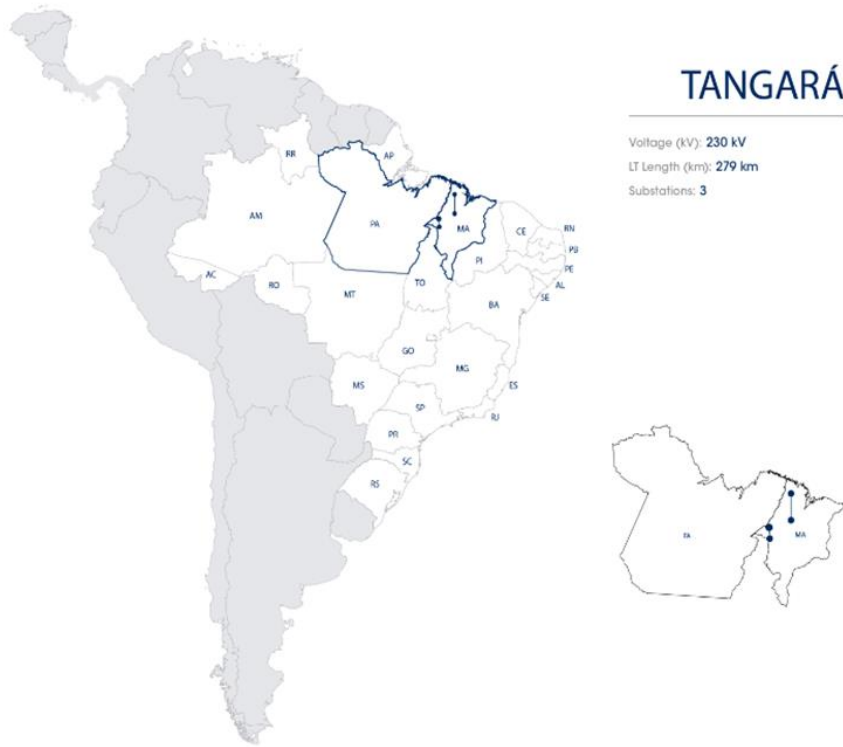
Transmissora Aliança de Energia Elétrica S.A. (B3: TAEE3, TAEE4 and TAEE11) ("**TAESA**" or "**Company**") hereby informs its shareholders, the market in general, and other interested parties that the National System Operator ("**ONS**") has issued the Release Terms related to the energization of the Dom Eliseu II Substation, the Açailândia–Dom Eliseu II Transmission Line and the complement of the Açailândia substation (SE) under the concession of Tangará Transmissora de Energia Elétrica S.A. ("**Tangará**").

With this energization, Tangará's Annual Permitted Revenues ("**RAP**") increases by approximately R\$ 23.6 million (for the 2025-2026 cycle), grossed up by PIS/COFINS, corresponding to 21.8% of the project's total RAP, effective retroactively from May 3 to May 6, 2026.

It is worth noting that the Tangará project was already partially operational, with an enabled RAP of approximately R\$ 58.2 million, as disclosed on the notices published between March and April 2026. With this energization, the total enabled RAP amount is now approximately R\$ 81.8 million (for the 2025-2026 cycle), plus PIS/COFINS, corresponding to 75.6% of the project's total RAP.

The project was partially delivered between 22 and 24 months ahead of the regulatory deadline established by ANEEL of March 2028. This milestone reinforces TAESA's execution capability and commitment to its strategic pillars of sustainable growth, financial discipline, operational efficiency, and value creation.

Tangará is a project corresponding to Lot 3 of Transmission Auction No. 02/2022, held in December 2022, and is 100% controlled by TAESA. Tangará has a total RAP of R\$ 108.3 million for the 2025–2026 cycle and an ANEEL-approved Capex of R\$ 1,117 million. The project is located in the states of Maranhão and Pará, with approximately 279 km of transmission lines, including 72 km of double-circuit lines.
