NOTICE TO THE MARKET

Transmissora Aliança de Energia Elétrica S.A. (B3: TAEE3, TAEE4 and TAEE11) ("**TAESA**" or "**Company**") informs its shareholders, the market in general and other interested parties that on March 13, 2025, the concessions Interligação Elétrica Aimorés S.A. ("**Aimorés**") and Interligação Elétrica Paraguaçu S.A. ("**Paraguaçu**") signed the First Amendments to Concession Contracts No. 04/2017 and 03/2017 with the Union, respectively, extending the terms of the concessions as follows:

- **Aimorés:** 55 (fifty-five) days, with a new end date of April 6, 2047.
- **Paraguaçu:** 138 (one hundred and thirty-eight) days, with a new end date of June 28, 2047.

The addendum is the result the request being granted for recognition of exclusion of liability for the delay in the start of commercial operations of the Aimorés (Case No. 48500.906562/2022-76) and Paraguaçu (Case No. 48500.908199/2022-23) projects. ANEEL's Collegiate Board, upon recognizing the impacts of COVID-19 on the contracts' construction timelines, determined the compensation of losses suffered by Aimorés and Paraguaçu through the proportional extension of the concession contracts term.

Aimorés and Paraguaçu are concessions in which TAESA entered in partnership, in equal proportion of 50%, with ISA Energia Brasil S.A. and began operations in 2022. Aimorés has a total RAP of R\$ 113.8 million (2024-2025 cycle plus PIS/COFINS), and is located in the state of Minas Gerais, with an extension of 208 km of line with a voltage of 500 kV, interconnecting the Padre Paraíso 2 substation to the Governador Valadares 6 substation. Paraguaçu has a total RAP of R\$ 169.9 million (2024-2025 cycle plus PIS/COFINS) and is located in the states of Minas Gerais and Bahia, with a length of 338 km of line with a voltage of 500 kV, connecting the Poções III substation to the Padre Paraíso 2 substation.
