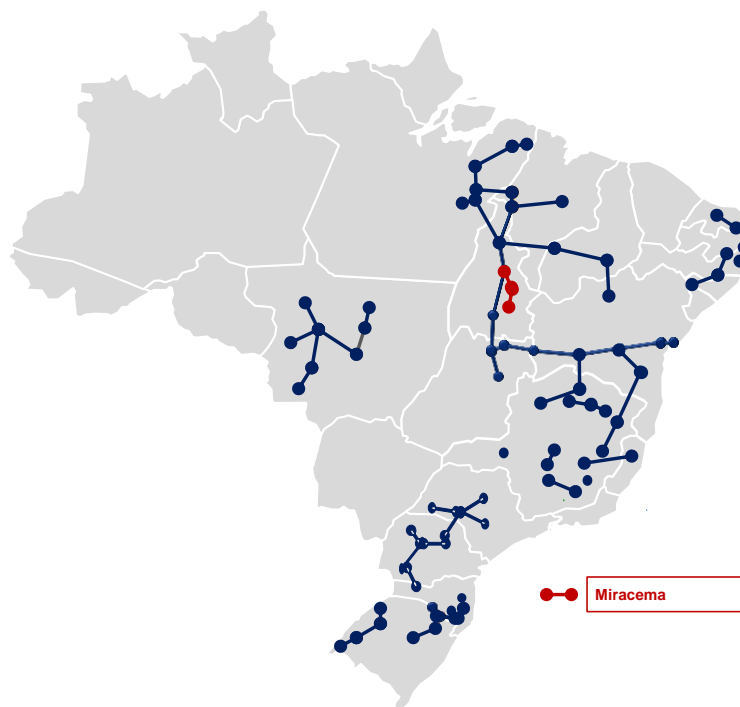

**NOTICE TO THE MARKET**

**Transmissora Aliança de Energia Elétrica S.A.** ("Taesa" or "Company") hereby announces to its shareholders, the market in general and other stakeholders that it has learned about the approval by the Superintendence of Development for the Amazon ("SUDAM"), through Resolution 221, for the 75% reduction in the Corporate Income Tax (IRPJ) – Deployment modality – for Miracema Transmissora de Energia Elétrica S.A. ("Miracema"), which will give it the right to tax incentives. Miracema is then obliged to inform SUDAM of the effective operation entry, in the year of its occurrence, during when it must provide the information required at the current regulation, in order to issuing the appraisal report for the fruition of the tax benefit.

Miracema is a project fully owned by Taesa and currently under construction from Lot P of the transmission auction 013/2015, held in April 2016. This project is located in the state of Tocantins, with a total extension of 90 km in transmission lines and 3 substations, totaling R\$ 276 million in investments (ANEEL Capex) and Annual Permitted Revenues (RAP) of R\$ 62.1 million for the 2018-2019 cycle. The deadline set by ANEEL to energize Miracema is December 2019.



This approval demonstrates Taesa's focus on the execution and delivery of the 8 projects under construction, totalling R\$ 3.2 billion in investments and R\$ 584 million in RAP (Taesa's stake), as well as on the materialization of a series of project efficiencies in order to boost their returns.
